# UB Zoom

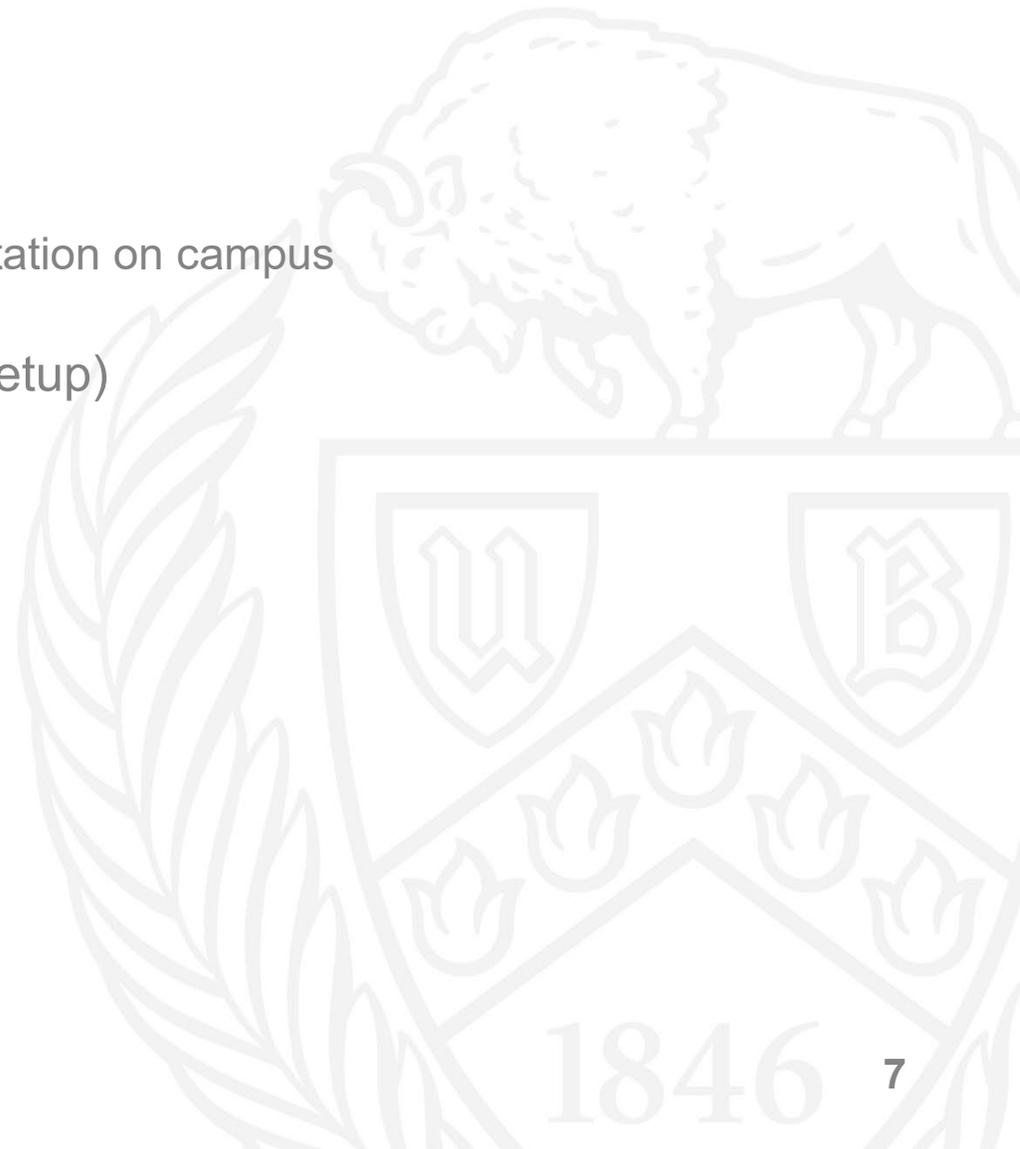
- **Claim your Zoom Pro account by logging into <https://buffalo.zoom.us> with your UB credentials**
- Install the client for your computer from the same site
- Always join or host meetings from the client software which is logged in with your UB account by clicking SSO
  - Certain features of Zoom meetings can only be performed when done through the software.

# UB File Systems

- University at Buffalo File System (UBFS)
  - UB housed file storage
    - Default save location when working on any Lab Workstation on campus
  - Follows you wherever YOU are logged in
  - Can be accessed from personal devices (moderate setup)
  - Limited space (256MB)
  - Strict privileges

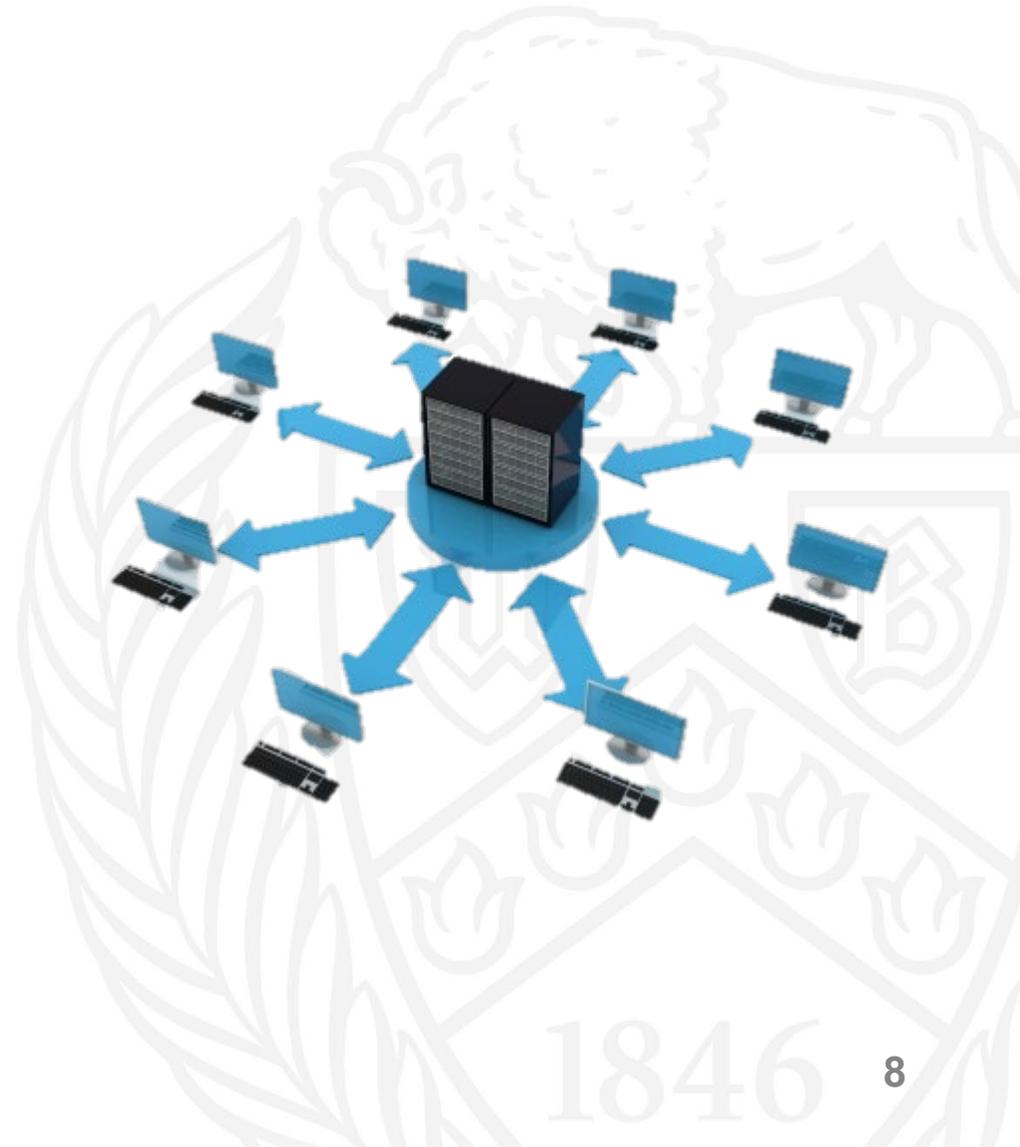

- Third party cloud storage
- Follows you wherever YOU are logged in
- Can be accessed from personal devices (easy setup)
- 128GB space
- Customizable privileges



# Law Lab Hardware Information

- All workstations are VDI (Virtual Desktop Infrastructure) devices
  - Virtual instance of a computer from a server
  - Slow login as each attempt counts as your first
  - Quick performance once logged in
  - All changes made to computer are reverted at logoff
  - Internet dependent (if network is down devices will not function)



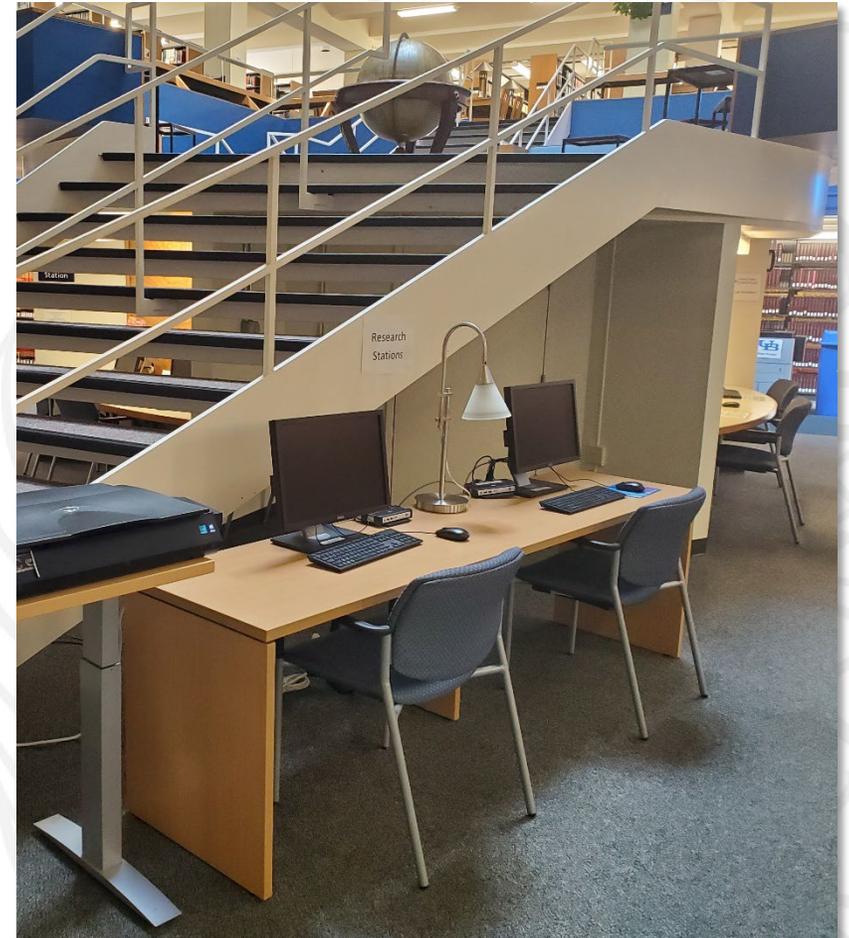
# Workstation Identification

- Cybrary Workstations
  - Universally accessible by any UB student, capable of all the standard functions of a UB Lab Computer
  - Five stations located on the 3rd floor, south wall
  - Can print to WEPA system



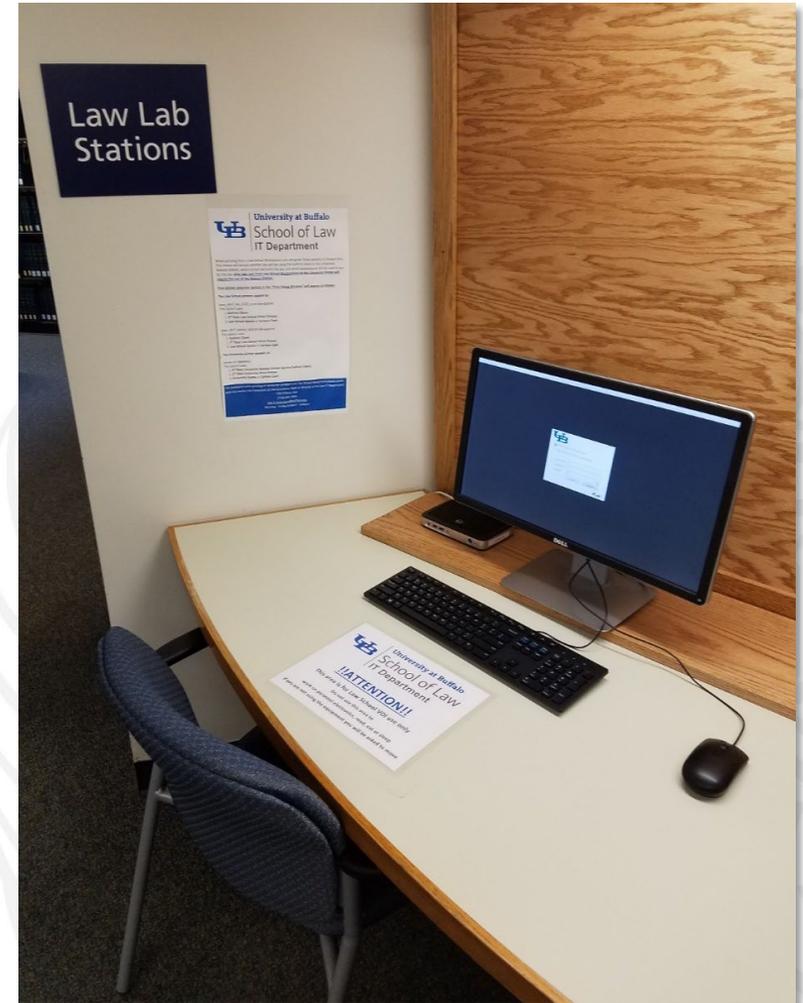
# Workstation Identification

- Research Workstations
  - Universally accessible by any UB student or individuals who are granted access, has no document creation / editing capabilities
  - Located throughout the Law Library
    - Two located on the 2nd floor, to the right of the stairs
    - Two located on the 3rd floor, north wall
  - Printing and Office software are not available



# Workstation Identification

- Law School Workstations
  - Accessible by UB Law students only, capable of all standard functions of a UB Lab Computer
  - Located throughout the Law Library
    - Ten located on the 2nd floor around stairs
    - Five located on the 5th floor
    - Six located on the 7th floor
  - Can print to WEPA system



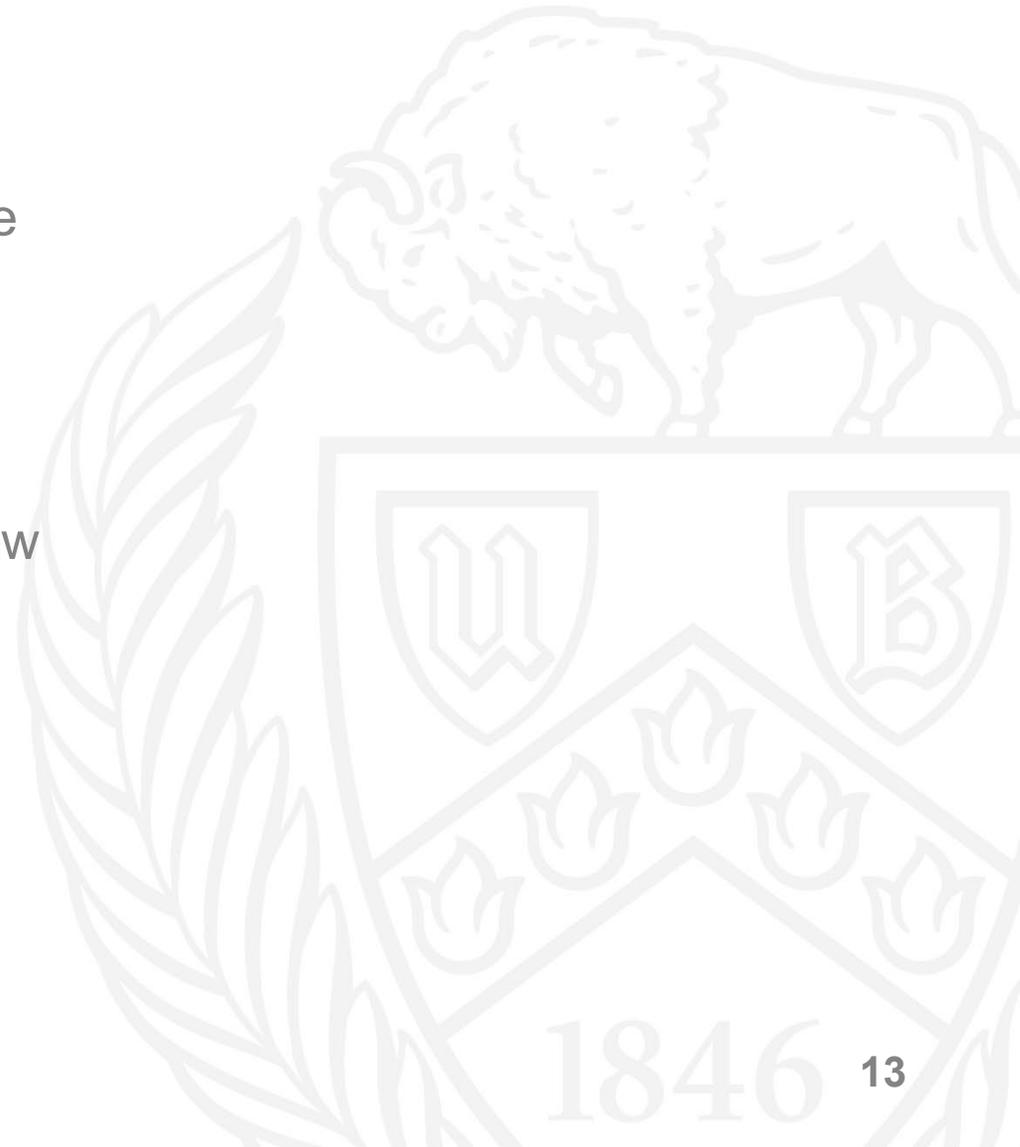
# UB Print Anywhere (powered by Wepa)

- UB students receive a semesterly quota of pages to print at any of 40 print station kiosks throughout the campus.
  - 500 pages for Spring and Fall
  - 200 pages for Summer (if enrolled)
  - 100 pages for Winter (if enrolled)
  - Add more pages through Campus Cash
- Two kiosks are located in O'Brian Hall
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Floor Lobby
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Outside the Library Entrance
- Flexible printing options (mobile device, personal computer, computing site, email, USB)

# School of Law Mobility Print

- UB students receive an annual quota of pages to print on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> floor of the Law Library.
  - 500 pages per year
- Print from your personal computer only

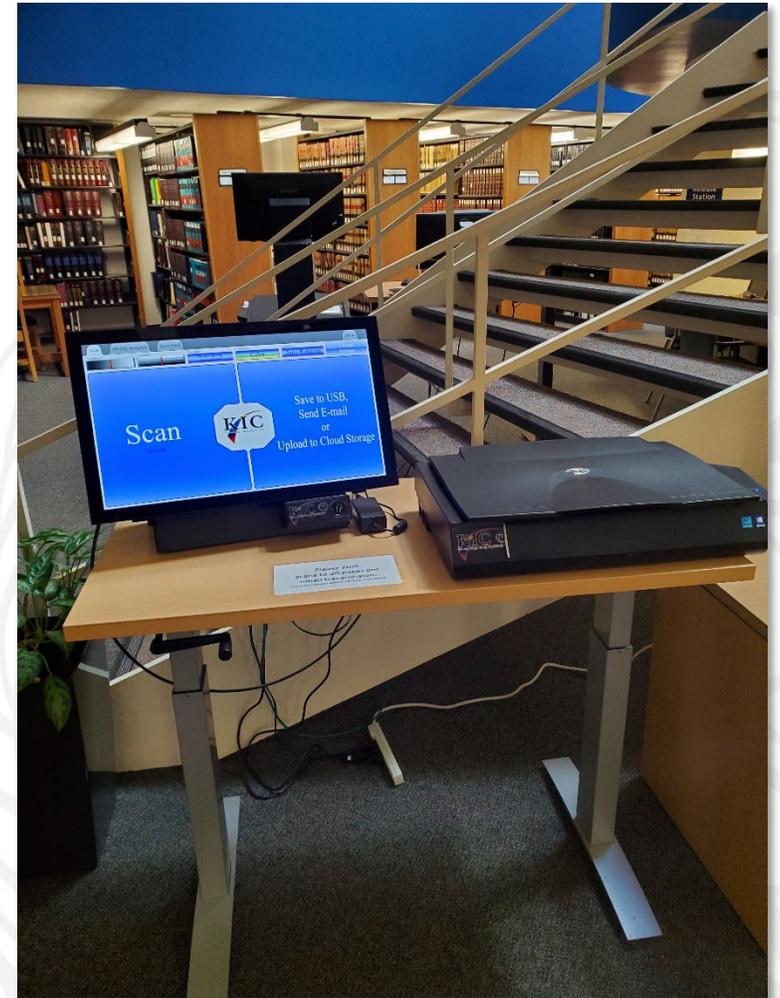
## Scanning on 5th Floor

- The printer on the 5th floor is capable of scanning single and multi-page documents. Scan custom sizes for books or non-standard documents.
- Book scan and single scans can be cumbersome, these types of scans are best suited to the scan stations on the 2nd or 5th floor.
- Requires a valid email address
- Defaulted file type is PDF
- Directions are available at the printer itself and online
- Cannot make copies



# Scanning on Scan Stations

- Scan Stations on the 2nd floor are capable of scanning single page documents. Can scan custom sizes for books or non-legal documents very easily.
- Multiple outputs
  - Scan to email, USB, barcode, cloud
  - Can scan as many file extensions
- Cannot make copies



# Exams using Exemplify

Exemplify is an exam delivery software licensed by ExamSoft Worldwide Inc. The program serves as a simplified word processor that enables students to take an examination on a laptop computer. Exemplify provides instructors the ability to lock down all Windows applications thereby providing exam security.

If you are taking an exam through Exemplify, you are expected to provide your own Exemplify capable device.
