Communication Skills

SIA's will sharpen their written and oral communication skills. Ambassadors will present in UB 198 and 199 seminars about the importance of Academic Integrity.

Micro-Credential

SIA's have the opportunity to earn a micro-credential in Academic Ethics. In addition to serving for two semesters as a Student Integrity Ambassador, you will complete a capstone project. Through the capstone project, you will incorporate your knowledge of academic ethics into a final essay.

Leadership

SIA's have the opportunity to gain valuable leadership experiences through professional development workshops that take place throughout the year. Ambassadors will also lead event planning efforts for office events.

Office Operations
