Why choose this minor?

- Develop your leadership and interpersonal skills and boost your employment prospects, regardless of your major.
- A recent survey by the National Association of Colleges and Employers (2024) revealed that the top 5 key attributes that employers look for in new graduates are problem-solving, teamwork, communication, initiative and a strong work ethic.
- The Organizational Leadership minor will help you develop and apply these sought-after skills and prepare you for leadership positions.

What are admissions requirements?

- You must be enrolled in any UB bachelor's program, other than the Bachelor of Science in business administration.
- You must have completed at least 30-credit hours with a minimum overall GPA of 2.0

What are the requirements of the Minor in Organizational Leadership?

- To obtain a minor in Organizational Leadership, you must earn a total 18 credits, including 12 credits of required courses (PSY 101, MGG 150, MGB 301 and MGB 370).
- Six credits of electives (choose two from MGI 301, MGI 440, MGB 425, MGB 437, MGG 380 or MLS 401).
