

SUMMER JOB OPPORTUNITY for 1L & 2L Students!

The Office of Diversity, Equity and Inclusion at The University at Buffalo School of Law is accepting applications for **two (2) Virtual Resident Assistant (VRA) positions** for the Discover Law Pre-Law Undergraduate Scholars (PLUS) Program. The RAs will serve as mentors to 20 PLUS Program Scholars, provide academic assistance, facilitate virtual study groups, and plan/lead virtual social events. The RAs will be on-call weekdays and for two weekends each during June, attend all virtual activities throughout the month of June, and assist with various student concerns in class. The time requirement is about 30 hours per week with some schedule flexibility.

Prior experience as a Resident Assistant is desired; candidates must have strong leadership skills and be comfortable with students of diverse backgrounds. RAs must be available May 26th – June 25th. **Pay is \$2,000.**
